TOUR# 7A MOUNT WASHINGTON COG RAILWAY (DIESEL-POWERED)

Lunch on your own at the base cafeteria before boarding the train.

A ride up Mount Washington on the world's first mountain-climbing cog railway continues to thrill passengers from all over the world with its dramatic ascent to the summit of the highest peak in the Northeast. With an average grade of 25% (some sections approach nearly 38%), it's also the second steepest!

Once at the top, 6,288 feet above sea level, you will have photo opportunities, along with a visit to the Observatory Museum. On a clear day, the view extends all the way to the Atlantic Ocean; other days you literally climb above the clouds.

Motive power is a fleet of seven powerful biodiesel locomotives, each custom designed, built and maintained on site. And with a nod to its steam heritage, the railway also continues to operate a pair of coal-fired steam engines in the warmer months, both well over a century old.

TOUR# 7B MOUNT WASHINGTON COG RAILWAY (STEAM-POWERED)

This is the same tour as 7A, with the exception of the motive power and the departure and return times.
